ORDINANCE NO. 2021-9

CALENDAR YEAR 2021 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 1.0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Penns Grove in the County of Salem finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2021 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Council hereby determines that a 2.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$112,872.30 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Penns Grove, in the County of Salem, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2021 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Penns Grove shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$158,021.22, and that the CY 2021 municipal budget for the Borough of Penns Grove be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-11

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2020-17, AMENDING CHAPTER 206 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNS GROVE

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2020-17 was an Ordinance previously passed by the Municipal Council requiring utilities under the control of the Board of Public Utilities ("BPU") to disconnect service from buildings set to be demolished within twenty four hours after notice, subject to fines for failure to comply; and

WHEREAS, the BPU, as a regulatory agency, has exclusive authority and jurisdiction over the regulation of public utilities including notice provisions;

WHEREAS, the Ordinance in its current form impermissibly conflicts with the statutory authority of the BPU under N.J.S.A. 48:2-13 and therefore is not legally sustainable,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Penns Grove, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, that Ordinance 2020-17 shall be repealed.

SECTION 1: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such consistency or inconsistencies.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as provided by law.
