AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 103-1 OF THE BOROUGH CODE PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT OF APPOINTED PERSONNEL

WHEREAS, vacancies do occur in appointed positions within the Borough of Penns Grove, requiring the temporary appointment of individuals to fill those positions,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Whenever a vacancy exists in the office of head of any departmental division by resignation, removal, disability or otherwise, the Mayor may appoint and the Borough Council approve the filling of the vacancy temporarily by appointing an acting head of the division, who shall have and perform all the functions, powers and duties of the division until the office shall be filled permanently. Any such temporary appointment shall terminate not later than ninety (90) days after the date of the appointment, unless the council shall, by resolution, authorize a maximum of two extensions of the ninety (90) day period.

SECTION 2:

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such consistency or inconsistencies.

SECTION 3:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as provided by law.
