**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FROM REMINGTON AND VERNICK ENGINEERS FOR
PREPARATION OF GRANT FUNDING APPLICATIONS FROM NJDEP
FOR REMEDIATION OF 76 S. VIRGINIA AVE.**

WHEREAS, the property known as Block 95, Lot 14 (76 S. Virginia Avenue) was the site of Akzo Nobel Coatings, Inc., a potential Brownfields site, and is under review relative to the need for Remediation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is eligible for New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund grant funding to cover cost associated with remediation of the site; and

WHEREAS, Remington and Vernick (RVE) has submitted a proposal to prepare grant funding applications for the Site and to develop a United States Environmental Protection Brownfields Inventory for the property; and

WHEREAS, RVE has submitted a scope of work proposal and is qualified to provide such services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Remington & Vernick to provide the services set forth in the scope of approval for remediation of the property at 76 S. Virginia Ave.
