RESOLUTION TO HIRE REDEVELOPMENT ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, the Borough of Penns Grove is in need of a Redevelopment Attorney;
and

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to nominate Edward Hill; and

WHEREAS, Edward Hill, Guzzo Law Firm, PC, has satisfied the criteria necessary
for this position; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Borough of
Penns Grove as follows:

1. This appointment is subject to the review and approval of the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between the Borough of Penns Grove and the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services.
2. Edward Hill, Guzzo Law Firm, PC, is hereby awarded a contract, pursuant to a fair and open process, to provide redevelopment legal counsel for services for the Borough of Penns Grove, effective January 1, 2024 and terminating December 31, 2024, which services shall be performed in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the attached supplemental documents which are filed in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.
3. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the written contract setting forth the terms of employment, which shall be consistent with this resolution and satisfactory to the Borough and the Borough Solicitor.
4. A notice awarding this contract shall be published in the South Jersey Times, as required by law, within ten (10) days after passage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk certify a copy of this Resolution and file it on the public record.
