**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNS GROVE MAYOR AND COUNCIL ADOPTING  
THE SALEM COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN  
UPDATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Borough of Penns Grove; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Penns Grove has participated in the preparation of the Salem County Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, a multi-jurisdictional, multi-hazard mitigation plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

**WHEREAS**, THE Salem County Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update includes:

- A Base Plan containing summary information common to all participating jurisdictions in Salem County, and
- The Borough of Penns Grove Appendix that identifies mitigation goals, strategies, and measures specifically for the Borough of Penns Grove to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people from the impacts of future hazard events and disasters; and

**WHEREAS**, adoption by the Mayor and Council demonstrates commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Salem County Multi-jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update;

**NOW, THEREFORE** in accordance with the Borough Council of the Borough of Penns Grove, Salem County, that:

The governing body of the Penns Grove Borough Council adopts the Salem County Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update Base Plan and the Borough Penns Grove Appendix including authorizing the formation and duties of the Borough of Penns Grove Hazard mitigation Working Group (Working Group) as follows:

1. The Working Group shall be convened by the Borough of Penns Grove Emergency Management Coordinator and will include representatives of the following departments, agencies, and organizations and other interested parties.
  - a. Office of Emergency Management – Coordinator
  - b. Office of Emergency Management – Deputy Coordinator
  - c. Borough of Penns Grove – Mayor
  - d. Borough of Penns Grove – Council President
  - e. Borough Administrator
  - f. Public Safety Administrator

- g. Code Enforcement
- h. Housing/Zoning Officer
- i. Public Works Supervisor
- j. Borough Engineer

2. The Working Group shall convene to conduct plan implementation and maintenance activities as identified in the Base Plan and Borough of Penns Grove Appendix including monitoring, evaluation, and updating the Borough of Penns Grove Appendix, conducting outreach and education for residents and property owners, and providing annual reports regarding progress in implementing the identified mitigation measures to the Penns Grove Borough Council and the Salem County Office of Emergency Management.
